Team Work

Both teams worked in groups, the Patrol leaders were so excited as their facilitator carried them through the theory and practicals since the scouts are tought to learn by doing.



Practical Skills

During the training the Patrol leaders were able to learn the practicality of food for life be making their own Garden, by plowing the land applying manure, planting the seeds, covering the ground, watering and fencing the garden.





The Patrol leaders were able to combine the knowledge studied at school and and from the program to go as far as educating each other further on the best ways the program can be localized to fit the conditions back home.

The Scout Leaders on the other hand debated aggressively on the ways of addressing the challenges to come in order to realize a success in the program putting in mind the challenges they faced in a similar program done before.



Food and Nutrition

An Apple a day keeps the doctor away, this was demonstrated after the participants savored on the delicacies presented to them during the program training, 5 meals a day was a satisfying experience for both the Scout Leaders and the Patrol Leaders which was a good live demonstration of what Nutrition is all about.

Apart from group facilitation and involvement, Individual interviews were undertaken to collect Private views on the feeling about the program and one Mrs Ecam Esther from Soroti Demonstration Primary School had a lot to share



Day2 ended with financial education and planning related to FFL Program that will enable them manage their produce and finances effectively and invest wisely

DAY 3: The day was welcomed with excitement from the previous day and anxiety to go back home ,share and implement the program.

Discussions blazed the room on challenges bound to be experienced and people were able to come up with local solutions to the problems.

Challenges discussed include

- 1. Inadequate monitoring tools and facilitation
- 2. inconsistent monitoring and evaluation
- 3. Absence of appreciation to the teachers running the program
- 4. fear of the project ending up as a trial and not being upscaled
- 5. Absence of the rewards after completion of each stage of the program
- 6. Late starting of the program due to election break interference.
